Happy birthday! Sunnyside Vineyard was planted in 1970, making it 50 years old this year! The wine from this carefully tended vineyard is always amazing. Lucy and Tom farm this predominantly Wadensville clone pinot noir with care, diligence and enthusiasm that undoubtedly contributes to fantastic wine year in and year out. My job is to make sure I don't mess up the beautiful fruit they bring me every year. Fruit, spice, acidity and tannin all seem to balance effortlessly making it tasty as they come.



tasting notes: Bright florals of violets, dried rose petal and lavender lure you into a juicy concentration of ripe and baked dark berry fruits. Freshly baked blackberry and huckleberry farmer's tarts, textures of cherry fruit-leather, clove and cola bridge into earthy notes of bay and tomato leaf, wet stone and lightly turned potting soil. Supple and balanced, elegant and harvest-stand ready.
