Inviting with a deep gravity. The airy notes of lilac, rose petal, and warm Earl Grey tea spice circle around a dense core of dried bramble berries, black cherry cola and pomegranate molasses. As time slowly passes, textures of nutty granola with spiced wildflower honey arise, complementing the dark, concentrated berry notes. Each sip invokes recollections of freshly-baked blackberry oatmeal bars. #breakfastofchampions

There is a product code on the bottom of each bottle so you don't have to unwrap them to identify the wines.
